1. Design as consulted	£1.54m £770/burial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides 1000 double-stacked burial plots, 2000 internment spaces</li> <li>Maintains buffer planting along Honor Oak</li> <li>Enhances car park and footpath layout</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Does not respond to the consultation responses</li> <li>Does not provide pedestrian/cycle access from Honor Oak station to recreation ground</li> </ul>
2. Traditional burial	£1.49m £714/burial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides 1050 double-stacked burial plots, 2100 internment spaces</li> <li>Provides traditional memorialisation</li> <li>Additional tree and planting</li> <li>Enhanced access with pedestrian and cycle pathways from Honor Oak</li> <li>A small pond added to help with drainage and help increase biodiversity on site</li> <li>The re-use of graves is possible in the future</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Only partially responds to the consultation in regard to the creation of a natural green space</li> </ul>
3. Meadow burial	£1.45m £746/burial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides 1050 burial plots (majority double-stacked, unless under trees), 1950 internment spaces</li> <li>Lower total cost than traditional option above</li> <li>Meadow grasses and additional tree planting across the site</li> <li>Pond feature added</li> <li>Pedestrian and cycle pathways from Honor Oak</li> <li>Meadow reaches maturity more rapidly than woodland</li> <li>Responds well to consultation by creating a less “managed” feel with without traditional memorials</li> <li>Re-use of graves is possible in the future</li> <li>Supports the fauna currently found on site</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Absence of traditional memorials could make it difficult to sell plots</li> <li>Those who want to visit the grave may be unable to identify the exact plot.</li> </ul>
4. Woodland burial	£1.31m £1246/burial	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lowest total cost</li> <li>Trees planted across the site</li> <li>Pond feature added</li> <li>Pedestrian and cycle pathways added from Honor Oak</li> <li>Responds well to consultation by creating a fully wooded area, without traditional memorials</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides only 1050 burial plots/internment spaces</li> <li>Highest cost per burial</li> <li>Absence of traditional memorials could make it difficult to sell plots</li> <li>Those who want to visit the grave may be unable to identify the exact plot</li> <li>Trees substantially limit the ability to re-use graves</li> <li>Longest time to reach maturity</li> <li>Revenue costs (management of woodland) greater than options 2 &amp; 3</li> </ul>

\*Please note, the cost per burial figures provided refers to the options’ total construction cost divided by the number of internment spaces produced.
