

## Frequently asked questions- North Peckham Healthy Streets

<p>Why are you proposing a controlled parking zone in this area?</p>	<p>We have received numerous requests over the last few years for a controlled parking zone. We would like to know whether you have a problem parking in the area and if so what hours you would like the proposed parking zone to operate.</p>
<p>Have you previously consulted on the proposed cycling interventions?</p>	<p>In January to March 2018 we held three workshops to discuss any problems with cycling and parking in the area. Comments from the three workshops were used to inform the proposed designs.</p>
<p>Are you only proposing parking restrictions to accommodate the cycle route?</p>	<p>No, as the proposed parking zone and cycle route are in the same area we have decided to combine the consultation to ensure that we have a joined up approach and improve the area for residents, cyclists and pedestrians.</p>
<p>What is the expected effect of the closure on St George's Way?</p>	<p>If agreed, this closure will be under an experimental traffic order which means that we can monitor the effects and take comments from you. We expect that the closure will reduce the amount of vehicles travelling through the area while allowing access from the east through Cator Street and from the West via Chandler Way.</p>
<p>What are the charges for parking if the parking zone is implemented?</p>	<p>Please see our parking zone information sheet.</p>
<p>I cannot attend the drop in session; can I still speak to an officer?</p>	<p>Yes please use the contact number on the main consultation page.</p>
<p>What happens next?</p>	<p>The results of the consultation will be analysed, we will propose changes to the design based on your comments. The proposals will then be announced at the next community council meeting and then presented to the Cabinet Member for Environment, Transport Management and Air Quality for a decision which will be subject to statutory consultation.</p>
