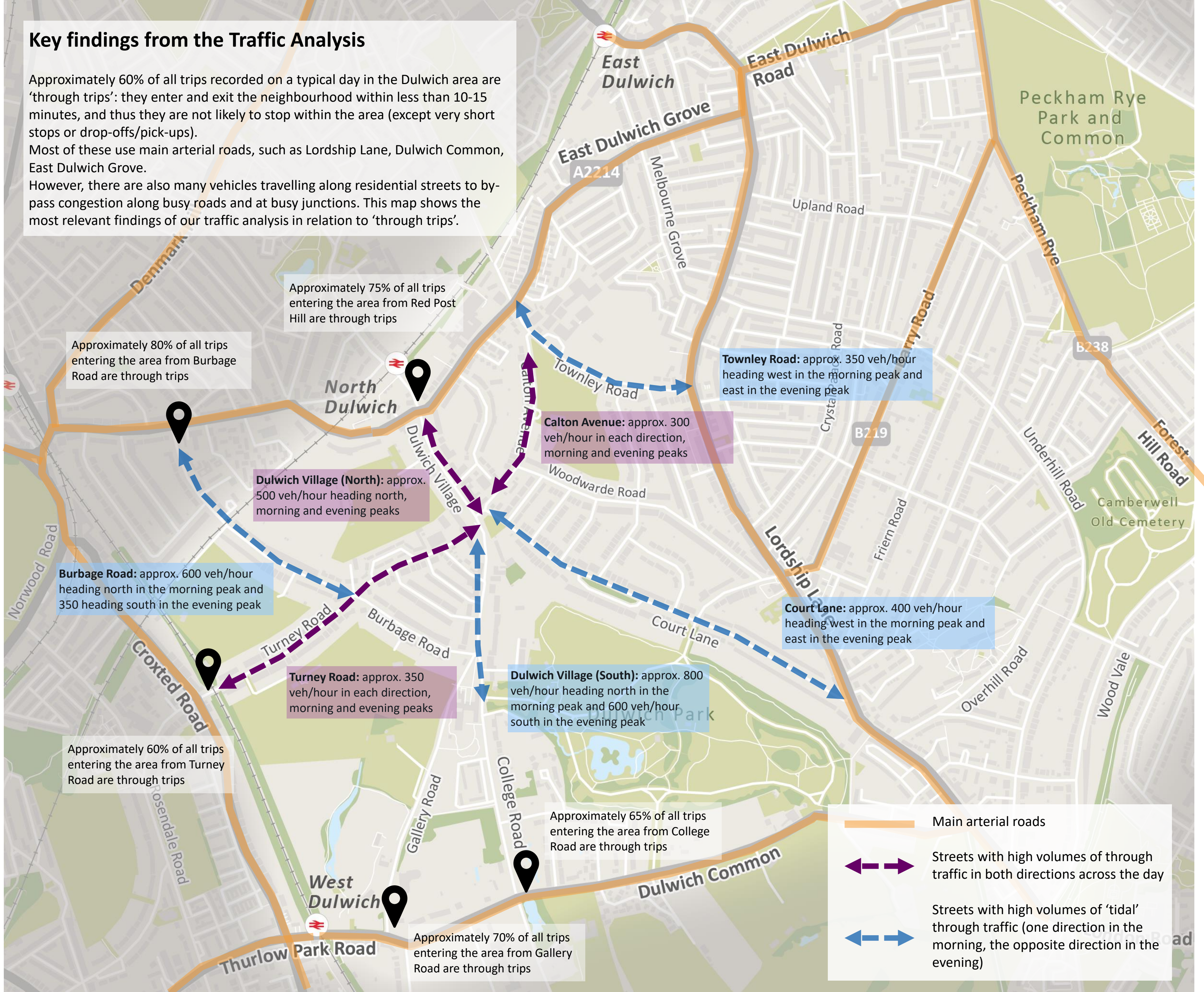


## Key findings from the Traffic Analysis

Approximately 60% of all trips recorded on a typical day in the Dulwich area are 'through trips': they enter and exit the neighbourhood within less than 10-15 minutes, and thus they are not likely to stop within the area (except very short stops or drop-offs/pick-ups).

Most of these use main arterial roads, such as Lordship Lane, Dulwich Common, East Dulwich Grove.

However, there are also many vehicles travelling along residential streets to bypass congestion along busy roads and at busy junctions. This map shows the most relevant findings of our traffic analysis in relation to 'through trips'.



**Main arterial roads**

**Streets with high volumes of through traffic in both directions across the day**

**Streets with high volumes of 'tidal' through traffic (one direction in the morning, the opposite direction in the evening)**
