The site on Fenham Road has been used for garages since being cleared after WWII.

Before the war the site was occupied by two houses. These were bombed during raids targeting the Old Kent Gasworks and almost entirely destroyed.

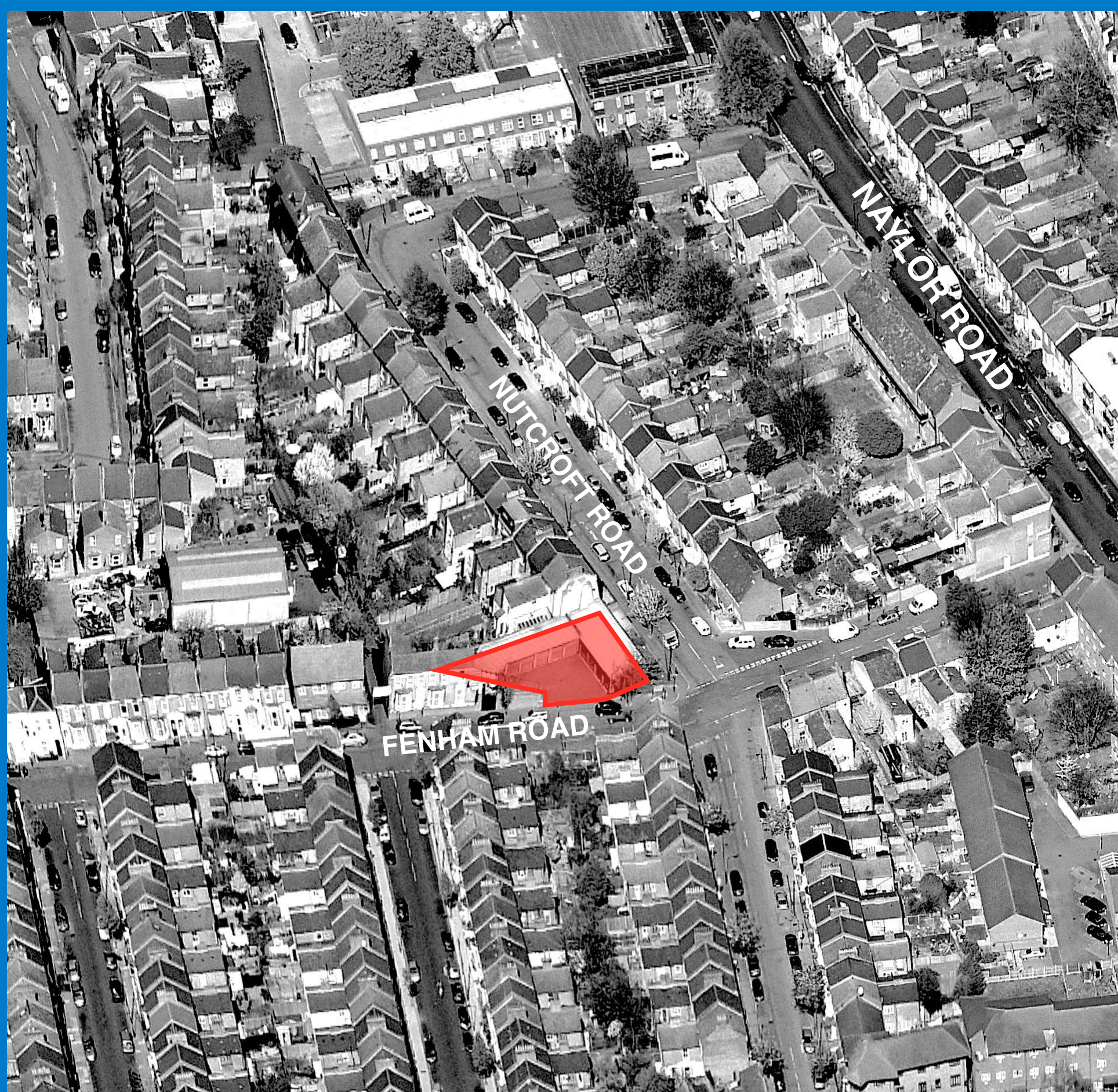
London County Council bomb damage map

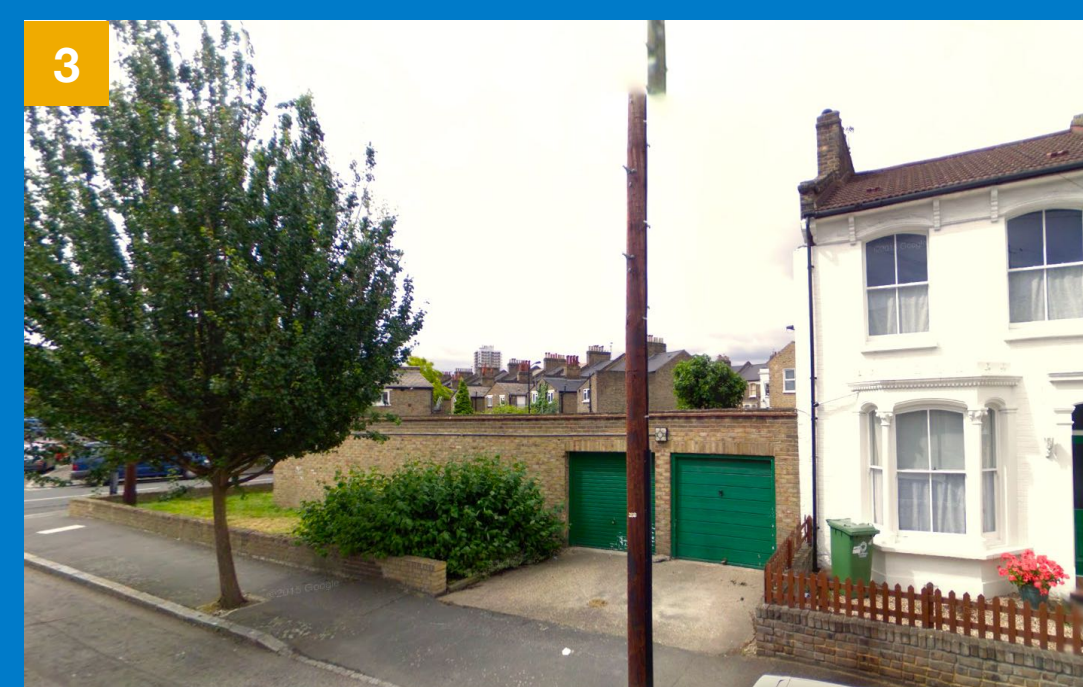


# Fenham Road site New homes

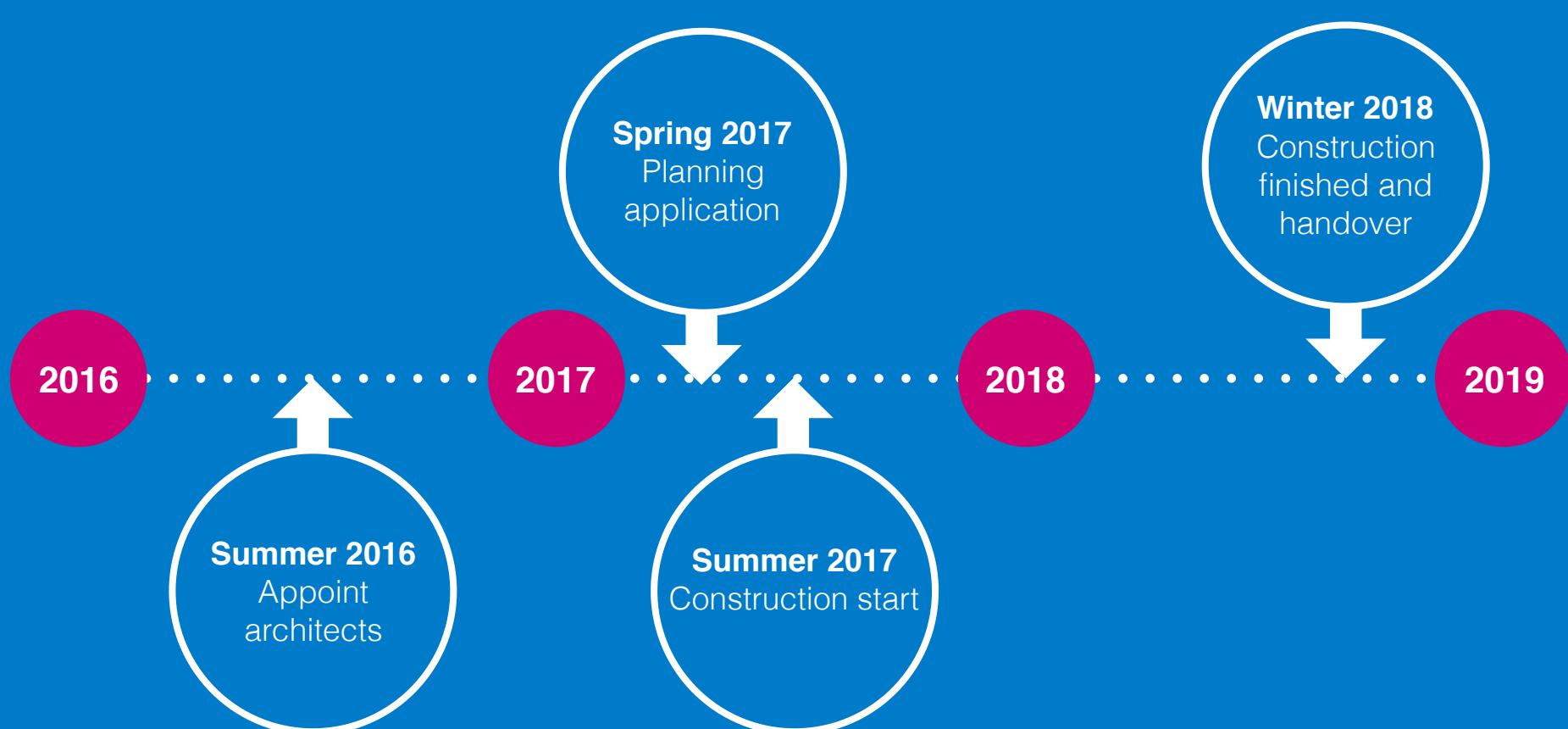


### Our proposal
